THE ACADEMIC LETTER

The Academic Letter, similar to a letter earned for athletic performance, is awarded for consistent dedication to academic achievement. The Caldwell Honors for Students Organization recognizes all Caldwell High School students, including those attending the Mid-East Career & Technology Centers and those participating in the Post-Secondary Educational Options Program, who maintain at least a 3.3 grade point average.

In order to qualify:

- ◆ Students must be enrolled full-time.
- ◆ Freshmen must earn at least a 3.3 grade point average for the first 3 grading periods in high school.
- ◆ Sophomores, juniors, and seniors must earn a 3.3 grade point average for the current school year which will also include the last grading period of the previous school year.

STUDENT OF THE GRADING PERIOD

Students are nominated for this award by the faculty each grading period for academic achievement or improvement, school involvement, or effort for the benefit of fellow students. Grade point average is not a factor to be considered.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

As monies allow, the Organization will make available forms of financial award to students.

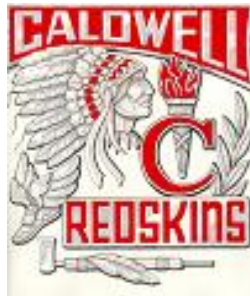
